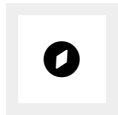

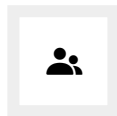

PROGRAM ITINERARY

DAY 1

ONTO BARCELONA

Mon. Jun 22, 2026

- Check out of the hotel and transfer to Madrid train station.
- Travel by AVE (high-speed) train to Barcelona.
- Arrive in Barcelona and begin with a panoramic tour of the city, including:
 - Passeig Maritim with its Columbus monument.
 - The world-famous Las Ramblas.
 - Lunch on own at the Boqueria Market.
 - Passeig de Gracia, Barcelona's main avenue and its Modernist houses designed by Antoni Gaudí.
- Continue to the port of Barcelona and, via cable car, begin the climb to Montjuich (or "Jewish Mountain") with spectacular views of the city below. Today, Montjuich Hill is a popular exhibition location. See the the Olympic Ring, the main stadium of the 1992 Summer Olympics.
- (Time permitting): Tour of the Joan Miró Foundation to enjoy the great artist's collection.
- Check into the hotel.

DAY 2

EXPLORING BARCELONA

Tue. Jun 23, 2026

- Visit Antonio Gaudí's unfinished monumental Church of the Sagrada Família.
- Continue to Parc Guell, exploring its mosaic-covered buildings, gardens, and panoramic views of Barcelona.
- Lunch on own, en route.
- 2000 Years of Jewish Life: A walk through the Gothic Quarter. According to archaeological evidence, there was a sizable Jewish community in Catalonia as early as the beginning of the Common Era. For centuries thereafter, the Jews of Barcelona managed their own local affairs and lived relatively well in their own Quarter.
- Stop at Casa Adret, the oldest building in the Jewish Quarter, formerly owned by medieval Jews and now functioning as the headquarter for Mozaika, a Jewish cultural center.
- Meet with volunteers at Mozaika over Jewish tapas. Inspired by family recipes and exploration of the Jewish table, their dishes tell a story that crosses worlds and generations.
- Visit the Medieval Synagogue discovered in the Call Quarter.
- Return to the hotel.
- Dinner with members of the local Jewish Community ATID.

The bank transfer should clearly state the beneficiary's name on the wire transfer.
